Past Actions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><input type="checkbox"/> Addresses past efforts made by key organizations that are involved in the issue<ul style="list-style-type: none">o GA: UN, NGOs, nations, and companieso Non-GA: Fictional, historical, corporate etc.<input type="checkbox"/> Analyzes the successes or failures of at least two past actions	2
Delegate Stance and Policy	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><input type="checkbox"/> Summarizes the country's (or character's) unique stance on the issue<input type="checkbox"/> Utilizes multiple pieces of research, such as but not limited to statistics, studies, definitions, and speeches	2
Possible Solutions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><input type="checkbox"/> Includes two achievable possible solution that is supported by their own policy<input type="checkbox"/> Improves upon the failures of past actions and connects ideas	2
Research	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><input type="checkbox"/> Correctly cites evidence by using a separate bibliography page, footnotes, and/or links	1
