Topic Background	<ul> <li>Includes an overview of the agenda, including a brief summary of the history of the issue</li> <li>Is not overly vague or detailed</li> </ul>	2
Past Actions	<ul> <li>Addresses past efforts made by key organizations that are involved in the issue         <ul> <li>GA: UN, NGOs, nations, and companies</li> <li>Non-GA: Fictional, historical, corporate etc.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Analyzes the successes or failures of at least two past actions</li> </ul>	2
Delegate Stance and Policy	<ul> <li>Summarizes the country's (or character's) unique stance on the issue</li> <li>Utilizes multiple pieces of research, such as but not limited to statistics, studies, definitions, and speeches</li> </ul>	2
Possible Solutions	<ul> <li>Includes two achievable possible solution that is supported by their own policy</li> <li>Improves upon the failures of past actions and connects ideas</li> </ul>	2
Research	Correctly cites evidence by using a separate bibliography page, footnotes, and/or links	1
Writing	Demonstrates fluency in English usage throughout the paper (well organized, contains minimal grammar mistakes, spelling errors, and typos) while maintaining an informative, formal, and professional tone	1
