Greetings!

We are delighted to invite you to the upcoming Global Education City Model United Nations (GECMUN) Conference, taking place on February 28th–March 1st (Fri–Sat), 2025 at the Shinhwa Landing Resort Convention Center in Jeju, South Korea. First founded and organized by the students and advisors of Korea International School Jeju Campus (KISJ), GECMUN has grown to be one of the largest international MUN conferences in South Korea and Asia since its first iteration in 2014. The latest iteration of GECMUN in March 2024 had 19 teams from 18 different schools and 5 different countries, proving how much the conference has grown from having 50 students in a small venue.

Organized by Korea International School Jeju, GECMUN offers diverse and challenging committees that simulate various United Nations committees, historical events, fictional scenarios, and crisis situations. GECMUN was one of the pioneer conferences to introduce crisis-style committees to South Korea and continues to provide a wide range of committee types led by skilled chairs.

Upon visiting Jeju Island, we highly recommend that attending schools explore and engage in the numerous tourist attractions available on the island. Students may enjoy hiking the renowned coastal trails, having a barbecue and bonfire on the beach, visiting the amusement park located near our hotel, or participating in many other exciting activities offered.

For visiting schools from the mainland or overseas, we recommend staying at the

Marriott Hotel or Shinhwa World Landing Resort, both conveniently located within the same building as the conference venue. An alternative option is the Jeju Aerospace Hotel, which offers a more budget-friendly choice, though it is a five-minute drive away from the venue.
