Dear Advisors and Administrators,

We cordially invite you to attend the Global Education City Model United Nations (GECMUN) conference taking place February 11-12 (Fri/Sat) 2022 at the Shinhwa Landing Resort located on Jeju Island.

The conference will be hosted by Korea International School Jeju (KISJ). Since 2014, GECMUN has been the fastest growing MUN conference in South Korea. What started as a conference with no more than fifty delegates quickly grew into a conference with over a dozen schools from six different countries in 2021, and we look forward to continued growth in both size and quality as we continue to expand our program.

What makes us unique is that our conference comprises small yet challenging committees simulating not only various United Nations committees, but historical and fictional committees as well. We are the only conference in South Korea currently offering “crisis committees,” led by skilled directors who have had numerous years of experience both domestic and abroad.

Schools visiting Jeju Island for our conference are also strongly encouraged to partake in the many tourist activities available. Your students may enjoy hiking the popular costal trails, enjoying barbecue and bonfires on the beach, visiting the amusement park adjacent to our hotel, or any of the various other activities.

Costs & Accommodation

In regards to accommodation, GECMUN VII provides a discounted rate at the Shinhwa Landing Resort. The price is 110,000 KRW (VAT included) for a 2-person room with two twin beds, or 140,000 KRW (VAT included) for a 3-person room with a queen-sized bed and a twin-sized bed.

There is no school registration cost and no hidden fees. We are transparent about our costs and are willing to answer any and all questions in regards to GECMUN VII expenses. We are a not-for-profit conference and are dedicated to using all fees to improve the quality of the conference for the delegates.

What is included with the registration fee:

- GECMUN Swag (water bottle, pens, note pads, and sweatshirt).
- Stationery & Paper (including firm paper for name cards and placards)
- Facility cost (the cost to rent out the various conference rooms and ballroom from Shinhwa Landing Resort. This is the largest expense we incur as a conference.)
- Bus transportation on the island
- Awards/plaques
- MUN related material cost (including the chairs' gavels, color printing fees, room props such as maps, and any other fees which may be part of running a committee)
- Pins. Every committee will come with pins representing the delegate's country or the committee in general (if it is a crisis committee).
- Water and coffee for delegates and advisors

Not included with the registration fee:

- Lunch. Given the new location of our conference, delegates are encouraged to explore the various restaurants at Shinhwa World and choose where they would like to eat.
