Dear Advisors and Administrators,

We cordially invite you to attend the Global Education City Model United Nations (GECMUN) conference taking place February 17-18 (Fri/Sat) 2023 at the Shinhwa Landing Resort located on Jeju Island.

The conference will be hosted by Korea International School Jeju (KISJ). Since 2014, GECMUN has continued to grow in size and quality. Starting with fewer than fifty delegates from three schools, GECMUN has since grown into a conference of over two hundred delegates. To date, over twenty schools from six different countries have participated.

What makes us unique is that our conference is composed of small yet challenging committees, simulating not only various United Nations committees, but historical and fictional committees as well. We are the only conference in South Korea currently offering “crisis committees,” led by skilled directors who have had numerous years of experience both domestically and abroad.

Schools visiting Jeju Island for our conference are also strongly encouraged to partake in the many tourist activities available. Your students may appreciate hiking the popular coastal trails, enjoying a barbecue and bonfires on the beach, visiting the amusement park adjacent to our hotel, or many of the various other activities available.

# Costs & Accommodation

We recommend that visiting schools stay at the Marriott Hotel or the Jeju Landing Resort which are both within walking distance of the convention center where the conference is held. Alternatively, the less-expensive Jeju Aerospace Hotel is a five-minute drive from the venue.

There is no school registration cost and no hidden fees. We are transparent about our costs and are willing to answer any and all questions in regards to GECMUN IX expenses. We are a not-for-profit conference and are dedicated to using all fees to improve the quality of the conference for the delegates.

## What is included with the registration fee:

- GECMUN Swag (water bottle, pens, note pads, and t-shirt)
- Stationery & Paper (including firm paper for name cards and placards)
- Facility cost (the cost to rent out the various conference rooms and ballroom from Shinhwa Landing Resort. This is the largest expense we incur as a conference.)
- Bus transportation on the island
- Awards/plaques
- MUN related material cost (including the chairs' gavels, color printing fees, room props such as maps, and any other fees which may be part of running a committee)
- Flags. Every committee will come with flags representing the delegate's country or the committee in general (if it is a crisis committee)
- Water for delegates and coffee for advisors

## Not included with the registration fee:

- Lunch. Given the location of our conference, delegates are encouraged to explore the various restaurants at Shinhwa World and choose where they would like to eat.
